

## Minutes: TRA Meeting 10/02/2020

Apologies from Grace, Alison, David, Lisa, Jane, Jessica and Lorna.

1) - Introduction of Mike Towers, new Manager HLCC, to the TRA.

- All present introduced themselves. Announcement of the welcome party to be held at the centre on March 2nd, 5.30pm to 7.30pm.

Danny asked about hours Mike will be working & when to see him. Mike said around 4-5 hours Monday to Friday, afternoons best.

2) Security / Neighbourhood Watch

- Roger introduces discussion on this with example letter for tenants / residents to set up neighbourhood watch groups within their blocks & proposes this

- also recommends people join the Holly Lodge WhatsApp group for reporting local anti-social behaviour

- Some discussion about the above and drugs / crime & anti-social behaviour on estate

- Lana raises issue of lighting on the estate as a good way to address people's worries as there is poor lighting on many parts of the estate.

There is some discussion of estate lighting and use of solar lights.

3) Football & Coach Trip

-Shannon says £1000 fund received via HLCC for Youth project will be used for a summer community coach trip to seaside. She will plan this with youth members

- There is a DMC bid for one year football training academy to start later this year at Acland Burghley school and Sasha will be mentored to be a trainer for this. It will be one evening a week, full details to be confirmed by Lana / Shannon & Sasha

-RESOLVED: Shannon to contact youth TRA members to plan coach trip and football academy

4) Sewage

-The Makepeace Mansions Drain overflow issue has now been resolved, but there is still issue in Langbourne & sewage is still overflowing.

Seems there is confusion from Camden over how exactly to deal with this, between them and their sub contractor London Drains and Thames Water

- Also a discussion on blocked Guttering which Grazyna & Roger had reported to Camden. A response was received from Andy Hardwich, but no visit after 3 weeks.

- RESOLVED: 1) Shannon will contact Camden Council to find who correct person is to deal with Drains

- 2) Shannon will contact Camden Council / Gavin Haynes to chase up guttering issue affecting blocks on Holly Lodge.

#### 5) Bins

- Yvonne says nothing back from Chris Slater yet on a quote he submitted for bin area construction on Holly Lodge Estate

So we do not have confirmation if Camden have approved these plans

Also we are not clear on what the Quote covers exactly

- Some discussion about possible use of food waste (vegetables etc) on estate as compost for gardening group

RESOLVED: 1) Yvonne to re-contact Chris Slater to find out exactly what quote covers & status of approval from Council

- 2) Shannon to discuss with Gardener (Emma) about possible use of vegetable food waste as compost.
